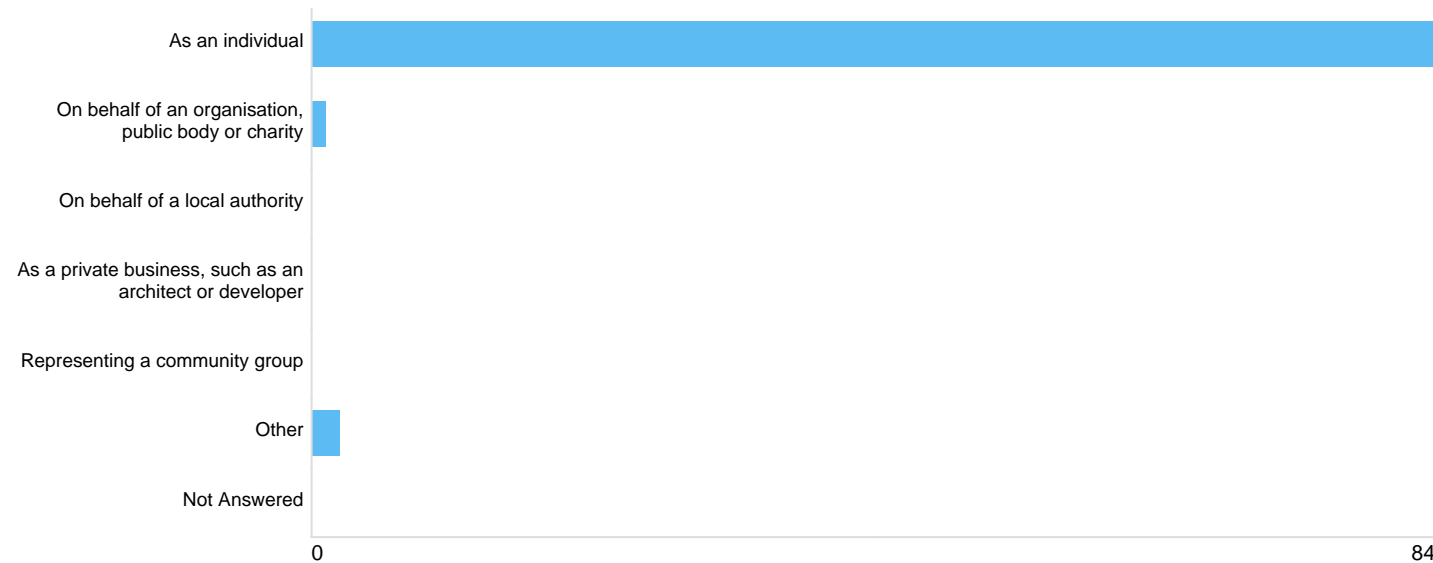

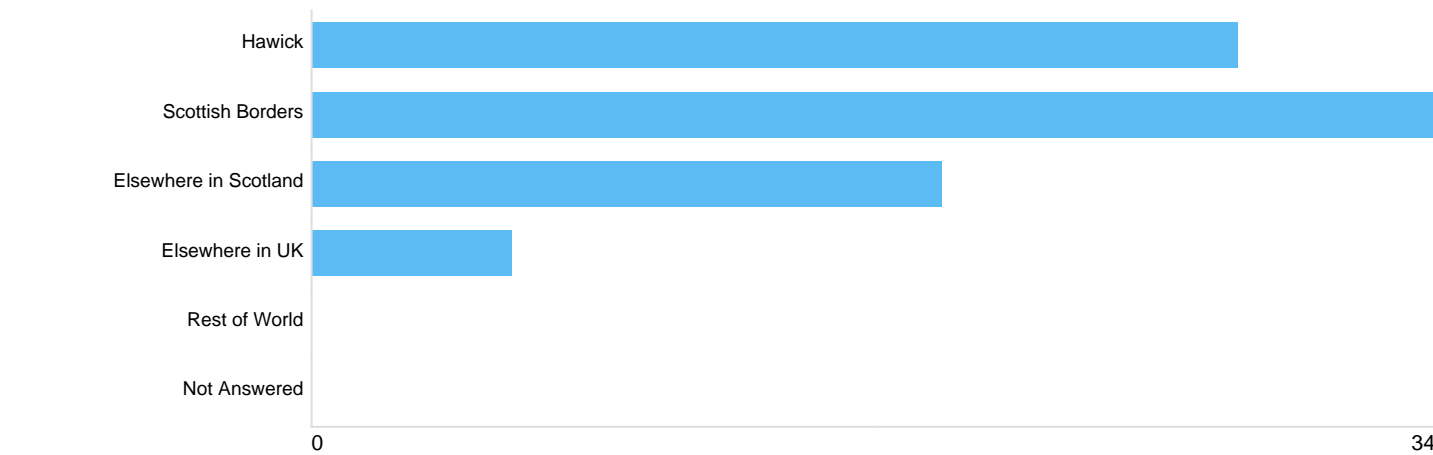

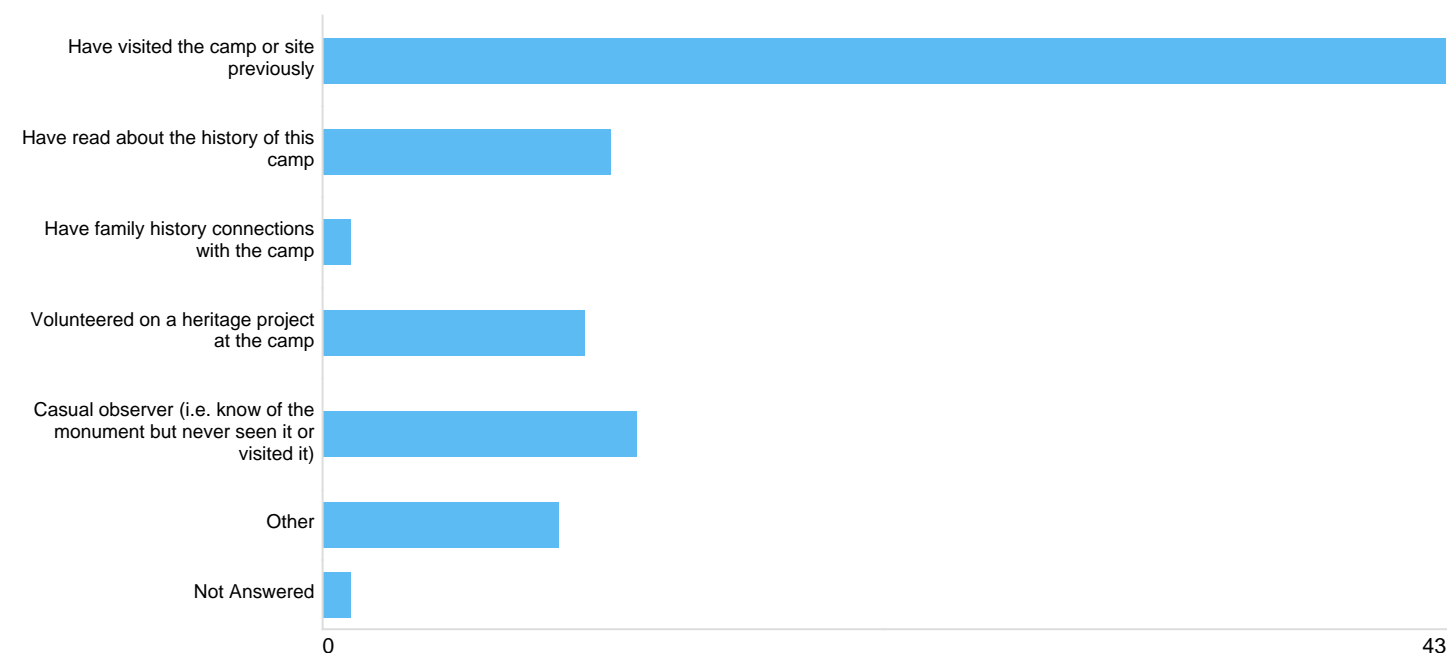

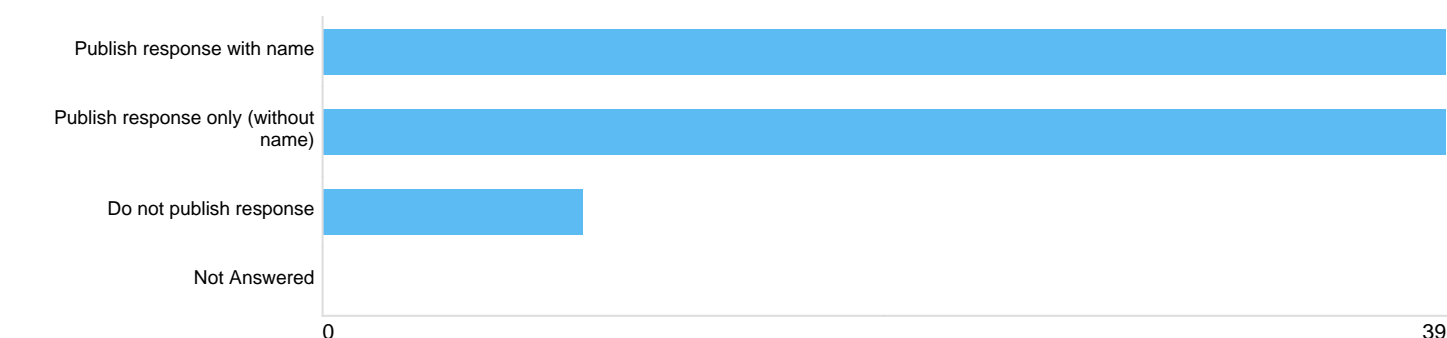

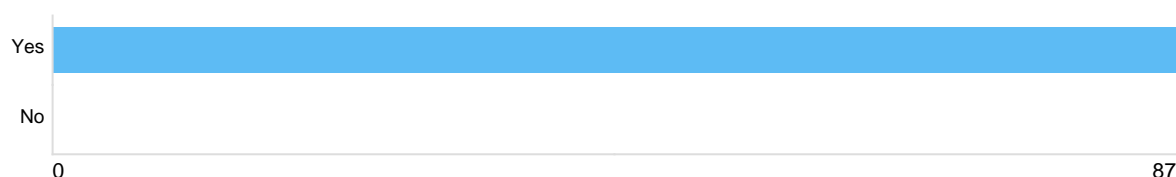

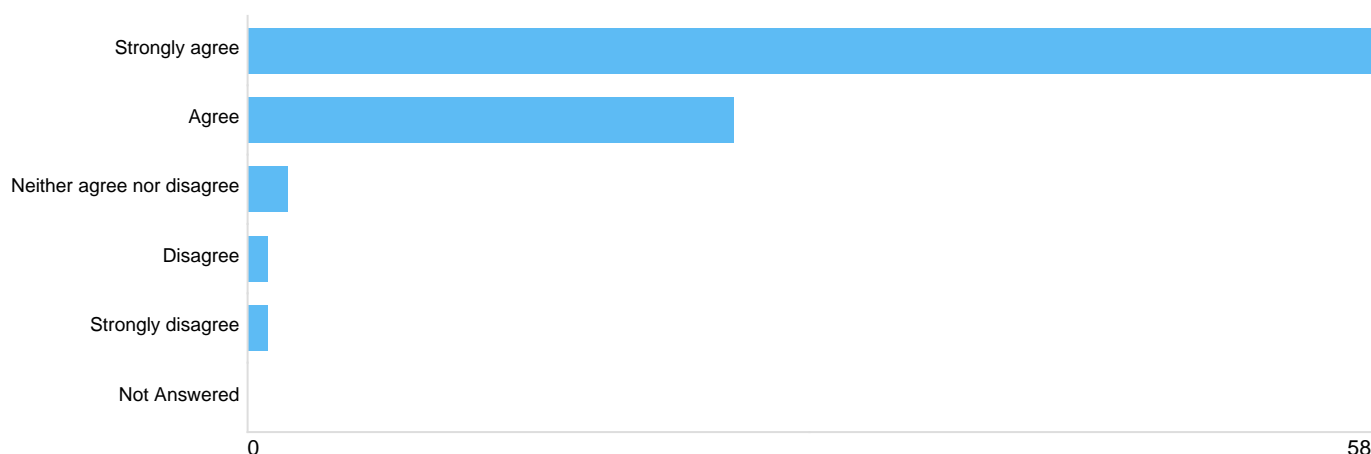

Intrinsic



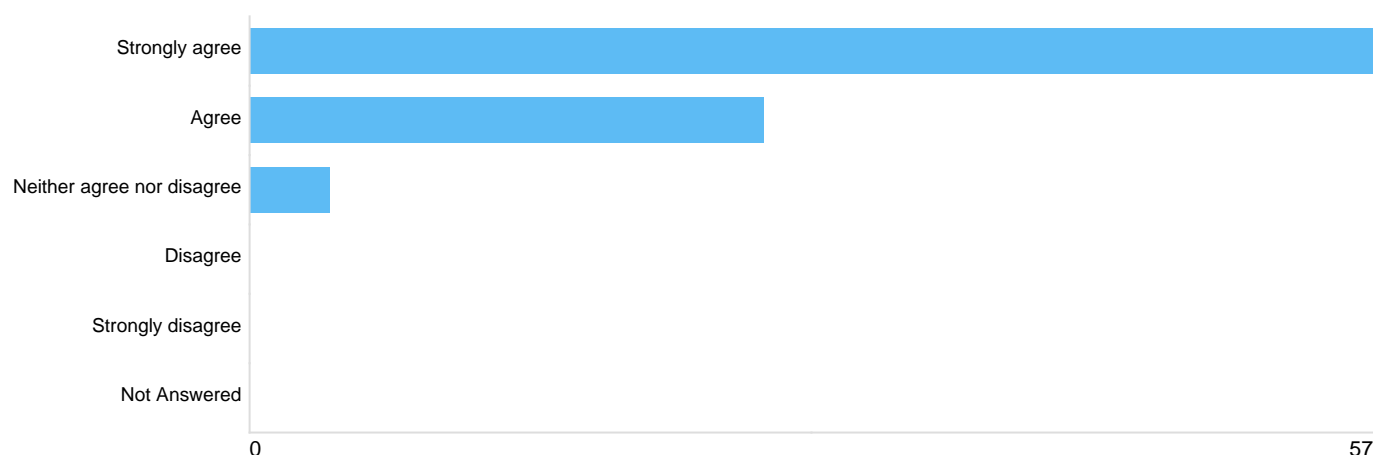

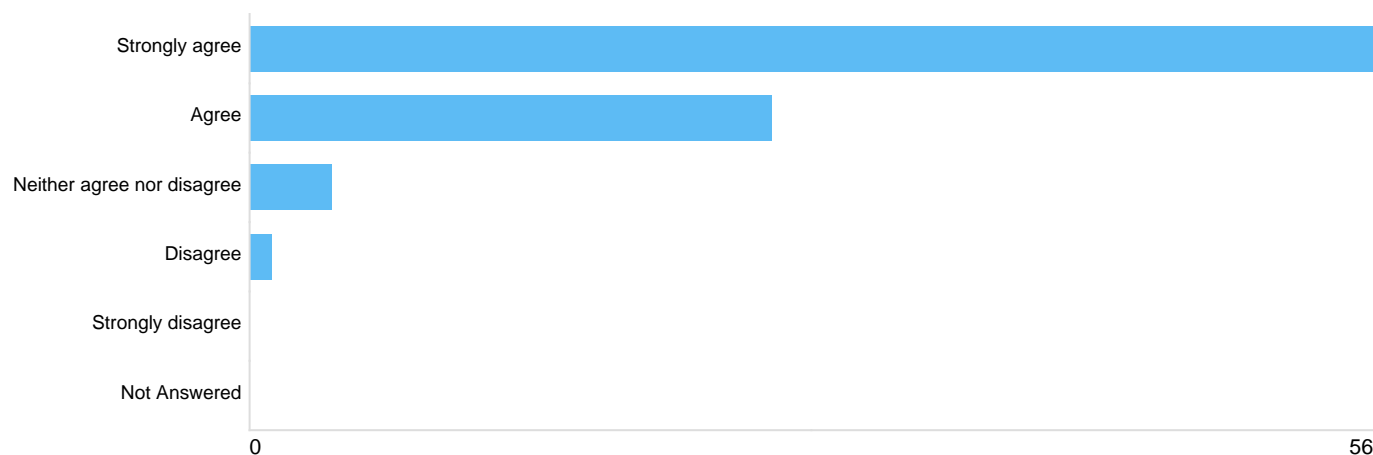
